

Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy contains important information on the different types of cookies that may be installed on devices when users visit the www.deparia.com website (hereinafter referred to as the “Website”). Pursuant to EU Regulation 2016/679 (General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter referred to as “GDPR”) and to applicable national legislation on the protection of personal data, cookies constitute personal data when they can be associated with a device and, therefore, to an identifiable person.

What are Cookies

Cookies are small text files that visited websites send to the user’s terminal (PCs, tablets, smartphones, notebooks), which are stored, to then be retransmitted to the same websites the next time the same user visits them. Several types of cookies exist, which contain different information (e.g. authentication of computer related information, session monitoring, storing of preferences to send advertising messages, etc.). Each cookie, in turn, contains different data (e.g. the name of the source server, a numeric identifier, etc.). Such data may be retained on the user’s device for different periods of time, such as for the duration of the browser session, for several hours, for several days or for longer periods.

Cookies are used for computer authentication, session monitoring and for storing information on websites. While browsing a website, the user may also receive on their terminal cookies that are sent by different websites or servers with respect to the current one (so-called “third party cookies”), on which certain elements may reside (such as images, maps, sounds, specific links to pages from other domains) present on the website that the same user is visiting.

The Website uses TECHNICAL Cookies. These cookies ensure the user a more responsive use of the Website and an easier retrieval of data, simplifying the connection and transmission of data between the user and the Website. They serve to facilitate the browsing of the Website or to provide a service requested by the user. Such cookies are not used for other purposes. Technical cookies are required for the correct and proper functioning of the Website. Without these cookies, certain operations may not be otherwise carried out or would be more complex and/or less secure. Technical cookies are, therefore, essential. Technical cookies do not require the user’s consent as they are necessary for the correct and proper functioning of the Website. In particular, we use temporary and permanent navigation or session cookies that guarantee the normal browsing and use of the Website, making it possible, for example, to save information relating to the browsing, to store data in order to maintain the browsing session active and/or to save information about full screen on/off settings during the browsing of the Website.

THIRD PARTY ANALYTICS Cookies

We also use analytics cookies (Google Analytics and Microsoft Dynamics) to collect information on the use of the Website. Similar to technical cookies, these cookies are treated in aggregate form to monitor areas that are most visited on the Website, to improve the content of the Website, to facilitate ease of use by the user and to monitor the correct and proper functioning of the Website.

The analytics cookies used are configured by a website other than the one the user is visiting. This takes place because each visited website may include elements (images, maps, sounds, specific links to web pages in other domains, etc.) that reside on a different server than the servers associated with the visited website.

We allow third parties to use analytics cookies on the Website in order to save preparatory information, in anonymous form, for creating reports relating to the navigation of our Website.

Cookies and browser settings

If the user's browser is not listed below, please refer to the instructions available on the specific browser concerning the management of cookies.

Apple Safari IOS

In order to disable cookies in the Safari browser, go to Preferences and from the Privacy Tab select the option to block cookies.

On iPads, iPhones or iPod touch devices, go to Settings, choose Safari and go to the “cookies” section.

Internet Explorer version 6 or higher

- Select “Tools” in the browser toolbar
- Select “Internet Options”
- Select “Privacy” and then click on “Advanced”
- Select “Override automatic cookie handling”
- Disable “Cookies on Websites visited” selecting “Block”
- Disable “Third-party cookies” selecting “Block”
- Disable “Session cookies” unchecking the “Always allow session cookies” option
- Click on “OK”

Firefox version 9 or higher

- Select “Tools” in the browser toolbar
- Select “Options”
- Select “Privacy”
- In the “History” area select “Use custom settings” from the drop-down menu
- Disable cookies by unchecking the “Accept cookies from sites” option
- Click on “OK”

Google Chrome version 24 or higher

- Select the “Chrome” menu in the browser toolbar
- Select “Preferences”
- Select “Show advanced settings”
- Under “Privacy”, click “Content settings”
- Disable all cookies by selecting “Prevent sites from saving data” and “Block third-party cookies and site data”
- Click on “OK”

SOCIAL NETWORKING BUTTONS AND WIDGETS

Social networking buttons are the “buttons” available on the Website depicting icons associated with social networks (e.g. Facebook, LinkedIn, YouTube, Twitter, etc.) that allow users to directly interact, with one “click”, with the relative platforms.
